COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 471

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-89-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 WHICH CREATES THE INFANT MORTALITY TASK FORCE, TO EXTEND THE 2 3 REPEAL DATE FROM JULY 1, 2001, TO JULY 1, 2005; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 41-89-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 41-89-1. (1) There is created the Infant Mortality Task 8 9 Force, the purpose of which is to foster the reduction of infant mortality and morbidity in Mississippi and to improve the health 10 status of mothers and infants. 11 The Infant Mortality Task Force is hereby continued and (2) 12 reconstituted as follows: The task force shall be composed of 13 eleven (11) voting members appointed as follows: 14 (a) The Governor shall appoint seven (7) members, one 15 (1) from each Mississippi congressional district and two (2) from 16 17 the state at large. (b) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint two (2) 18 19 members from the state at large. (c) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall 20 appoint two (2) members from the state at large. 21 (d) It is the intent of the Legislature that the task 22 force be comprised of persons with a professional association with 23 or special interest in maternal and infant health and well-being. 24 Any member of the Infant Mortality Task Force 25 (e) appointed and serving prior to July 1, 1995, shall be eligible for 26 reappointment to the task force. 27

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The Governor shall appoint two (2) members for initial (3) 28 terms that expire on June 30, 1996, two (2) members for initial 29 terms that expire on June 30, 1997, and three (3) members for 30 initial terms that expire on June 30, 1998. The Lieutenant 31 32 Governor and Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint 33 one (1) member for an initial term that expires on June 30, 1997, and one (1) member for an initial term that expires on June 30, 34 Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for terms of 35 1998. three (3) years from the expiration of the previous term. 36 No member shall serve more than two (2) successive full terms. 37 Any vacancy occurring other than by expiration of a term shall be 38 filled for the unexpired term by the appropriate appointing 39 40 authority. An appointment to fill an unexpired term shall not be considered as a full term. 41

The administrative head of the following state agencies (4) 42 shall designate one (1) employee to serve in an advisory capacity 43 as an ex officio, nonvoting member of the Infant Mortality Task 44 45 (a) Mississippi Department of Health; (b) State Department Force: of Education; (c) Department of Human Services; (d) Mississippi 46 47 Department of Mental Health; (e) Division of Medicaid; and (f) the University Medical Center. In addition there shall be one (1) 48 49 member of the Mississippi Primary Health Care Association who 50 shall serve in an advisory capacity as an ex officio nonvoting 51 member.

52 (5) The Chairman of the Senate Public Health and Welfare Committee and one (1) member of said committee to be designated by 53 the chairman, and the Chairman of the House Public Health and 54 Welfare Committee and one (1) member of said committee to be 55 designated by the chairman shall serve in an advisory capacity as 56 57 ex officio nonvoting members of the Infant Mortality Task Force. 58 (6) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2005. 59 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001. 60
