## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 488

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO MEMBERS OF LIONS OF MISSISSIPPI; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS IN SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MONUMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS IN 3 SUPPORT OF MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC EDUCATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO ACTIVE DUTY MEMBERS OF THE UNITED 6 STATES ARMED SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS FOR DULY ELECTED CONSTABLES; TO AUTHORIZE THE 7 8 ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS FOR MEMBERS OF THE 9 MISSISSIPPI STATE GUARD; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE 10 LICENSE TAGS IN SUPPORT OF THE INSTITUTE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES, 11 INCORPORATED; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE 12 TAGS TO MEMBERS OF KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS; TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO MEMBERS OF SOCIETIES SUCH AS 13 14 ACADEMIC, PROFESSIONAL, HONORARY, MASONIC, OR SO-CALLED GREEK LETTER FRATERNITIES OR SORORITIES, OR SIMILAR ORGANIZATIONS THAT 15 16 ARE IN GOOD STANDING AT ANY OF THE EIGHT STATE INSTITUTIONS OF 17 18 HIGHER LEARNING; TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS AUTHORIZED IN THIS ACT; TO PROVIDE FOR THE 19 20 DISTRIBUTION OF SUCH ADDITIONAL FEES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 21 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a member 22 of Lions of Mississippi, upon payment of the road and bridge 23 24 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 25 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 26 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 27 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 28 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a member 29 of Lions of Mississippi. The distinctive license tags so issued 30 shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission, 31 with the advice of Lions of Mississippi, may prescribe and shall 32 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary 33 34 to distinguish each license tag.

- 99 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
- 100 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
- 101 and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in
- 102 subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive

license tag in recognition of his support for the Mississippi

Veterans Monument. The distinctive license tags so issued shall

be of such color and design as may be determined finally by the

State Tax Commission based upon three (3) recommendations

presented to the State Tax Commission by the Mississippi Veterans

Monument Commission, and ranked in order of preference by the

Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission.

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- (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector as a processing fee, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund. Distinctive license tags issued under this section shall be issued within forty-five (45) days after application is made.
- Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 121 122 after July 1, 2001, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 123 124 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all 125 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 126 127 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 128 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 129 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 130 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 131 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 132 license tag, or if the owner sells or transfers the vehicle he, 133 134 may surrender the license tag to the local county tax collector and receive a certificate of credit toward the purchase of a tag 135

137 license tags issued under this section may be transferred by the

138 owner to any other vehicle owned by him upon payment of the

139 regular taxes and fees for a license tag for that vehicle.

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(7) There is established in the State Treasury a special fund which shall consist of monies required to be deposited therein under subsection (4) of this section. Monies in the special fund, upon Legislative appropriation, may be expended by the Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission for the purpose of performing any of the duties of the commission under Chapter 15 of Title 55, Mississippi Code of 1972. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in the special fund shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund.

The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission.

- The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 302 303 after July 1, 2001, any person applying for a distinctive license 304 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 305 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 306 307 other taxes and fees. trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 431 432 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 433 434 vehicle registered in his name identifying the person as a member 435 of the Mississippi State Guard. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax 436 Commission, with the advice of the Mississippi State Guard, may 437 prescribe, shall bear the words "Mississippi State Guard," and 438 shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be 439 necessary to distinguish each license tag. 440

The distinctive license tags authorized in this section shall be prepared by the State Tax Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the several counties of the state in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license tags, and the tax collectors shall be entitled to their regular fees for their services. Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the distinctive license tags shall present to the tax collector proof of their membership in the Mississippi State Guard by means of a certificate signed by the commanding officer of the applicant on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
