- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 37-9-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 37-9-101. Sections 37-9-101 through 37-9-113 shall be known 8
- 9 as and cited as the "School Employment Procedures Law of 1977."
- It is the intent of the Legislature to establish procedures 10
- for providing public school employees with notice of the reason or 11
- reasons for not offering an employee a renewal of his contract, to 12
- provide an opportunity for the employee to present matters in 13
- extenuation or exculpation in order for the board to determine 14
- whether the recommendation of nonemployment is a proper employment 15
- decision and not contrary to law, and not to establish a system of 16
- tenure. The administration of the school district may not 17
- terminate any employee contract for a constitutionally 18
- impermissible reason. The employee shall have the burden of 19
- producing evidence of any alleged violation of a constitutional 20
- right. 21
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22
- 23 and after July 1, 2001.
