HOUSE BILL NO. 531

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-943, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF JUVENILE OFFENDERS THAT MAY BE HOUSED BY 2 3 THE WALNUT GROVE CORRECTIONAL AUTHORITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 47-5-943, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 47-5-943. The Mississippi Department of Corrections shall 7 contract with the Walnut Grove Correctional Authority or the 8 governing authorities of the Municipality of Walnut Grove, Leake 9 County, Mississippi, to provide for the private housing, care and 10 control of up to one thousand (1,000) juvenile offenders who are 11 in the custody of the Department of Corrections at a maximum 12 13 security facility in Walnut Grove. The maximum age of any offender housed in this facility shall be nineteen (19) years. A 14 15 county or circuit judge shall not order any juvenile to be housed in the correctional facility authorized in Sections 47-5-943 16 through 47-5-953. Commitment of juvenile offenders shall not be 17 18 to this facility, but shall be to the jurisdiction of the department. The commissioner shall assign newly sentenced 19 offenders to an appropriate facility consistent with public 20 21 safety. Any facility owned or leased by the Walnut Grove Correctional Authority or the Municipality of Walnut Grove for 22 this purpose shall be designed, constructed, operated and 23 maintained in accordance with American Correctional Association 24 standards, and shall comply with all constitutional standards of 25

the United States and the State of Mississippi and with all court

orders that may now or hereinafter be applicable to the facility.
