HOUSE BILL NO. 590

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-41-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE PENALTIES FOR KILLING LIVESTOCK; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 3 INTENTIONAL KILLING OF LIVESTOCK FOR RITUAL PURPOSES SHALL BE A 4 FELONY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 97-41-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

97-41-15. (1) (a) Any person who shall intentionally or 8 9 maliciously, either out of a spirit of revenge or wanton cruelty or who shall mischievously kill, maim or wound, or injure any 10 livestock, or cause any person to do the same, shall be guilty of 11 a felony and upon conviction, shall be committed to the custody of 12 the State Department of Corrections for not less than one (1) year 13 nor more than ten (10) years, and fined an amount not less than 14 One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), nor more than Ten 15 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). 16

17 (b) Any person who shall intentionally or maliciously kill any livestock of another and dismember or mutilate such 18 carcass, or cause any person to do the same, shall be guilty of a 19 felony and upon conviction, shall be committed to the custody of 20 the State Department of Corrections for not less than one (1) year 21 nor more than ten (10) years, and fined an amount not less than 22 23 Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), nor more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) and any property used in the 24 commission of the crime shall be confiscated including, but not 25 limited to firearms, motor vehicles or any other weapon or other 26 property used in the commission of such crime. 27

No. 590 01/HR40/R1080 PAGE 1 (CJR\BD) In addition to any such fine or imprisonment which may 28 (2) be imposed, the court shall order that restitution be made to the 29 owner of any animal listed in subsection (1) of this section. 30 The measure for restitution in money shall be the current replacement 31 value of such loss and/or the actual veterinarian fees, special 32 supplies, loss of income and other costs incurred as a result of 33 actions in violation of subsection (1) of this section. 34

35 (3) For purposes of this section, the term "livestock" shall
36 mean horses, cattle, swine, sheep and other domestic animals
37 produced for profit.

38 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 2001.
