HOUSE BILL NO. 612

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 27-19-56.32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS IN SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI 3 VETERANS' MONUMENT; TO PRESCRIBE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL FEES THAT SHALL BE COLLECTED FOR SUCH LICENSE TAGS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 4 5 ADDITIONAL FEES SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN A SPECIAL FUND FOR USE BY 6 THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS' MONUMENT COMMISSION IN PERFORMING ITS 7 DUTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9
- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 10
- 11 27-19-56.32, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 27-19-56.32. (1) Owners of motor vehicles who are residents 12
- of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating 13
- to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment 14
- of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and 15
- registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 16
- passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 17
- and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in 18
- subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive 19
- license tag in recognition of their support for the Mississippi 20
- Veterans' Monument. The distinctive license tags so issued shall 21
- be of such color and design as may be determined finally by the 22
- State Tax Commission based upon three (3) recommendations 23
- presented to the State Tax Commission by the Mississippi Veterans' 24
- Monument Commission, and ranked in order of preference by the 25
- Mississippi Veterans' Monument Commission. 26
- Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 27
- 28 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
- prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 29
- additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, plus 30

31 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector as

32 a processing fee, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission

33 within seven (7) days of the date the application is made. The

34 portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall

35 be deposited into the county general fund. Distinctive license

36 tags issued under this section shall be issued within forty-five

(45) days after application is made.

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38 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or

39 after July 1, 2001, any person applying for a distinctive license

tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount

41 of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each distinctive license tag

42 applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all

43 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a

44 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established

45 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the

time the original application is made for a distinctive license

47 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of

48 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive

49 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive

50 license tag, or if the owner sells or transfers the vehicle he,

51 may surrender the license tag to the local county tax collector

52 and receive a certificate of credit toward the purchase of a tag

53 on another vehicle as otherwise provided by law. Distinctive

54 license tags issued under this section may be transferred by the

55 owner to any other vehicle owned by him upon payment of the

56 regular taxes and fees for a license tag for that vehicle.

57 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the

58 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,

59 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the

60 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of

61 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute

62 the Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of additional fees collected for each

63 such distinctive license tag issued under this section to the

- 64 credit of a special fund that is created in the State Treasury.
- 65 Monies in the special fund, upon Legislative appropriation, may be
- 66 expended by the Mississippi Veterans' Monument Commission for the
- 67 purpose of performing any of the duties of the commission under
- 68 Chapter 15 of Title 55, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 69 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 70 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 71 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 72 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 73 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 74 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 75 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 76 taq.
- 77 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 78 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 79 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 80 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 81 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 82 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 83 deposit in the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 84 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 85 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 86 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 87 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 88 and after July 1, 2001.
