HOUSE BILL NO. 627

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
2	1972, TO INCREASE THE ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED TO BE COLLECTED FOR
3	ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS DISPLAYING THE EMBLEM OF
4	PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES LOCATED IN OTHER STATES; TO PROVIDE THAT
5	PROCEEDS FROM THE INCREASED FEE SHALL BE DEPOSITED TO THE CREDIT
6	OF THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND AND EXPENDED SOLELY FOR THE REPAIR,
7	MAINTENANCE, CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAYS; AND FOR
8	RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 27-19-56.15. (1) (a) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
- 13 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws
- 14 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon
- 15 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes
- 16 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
- 17 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
- 18 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount of
- 19 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), shall be issued a distinctive license tag
- 20 that displays the emblem of any public university of his choice
- 21 located in another state.
- 22 (b) The design of the emblems for the distinctive
- 23 license tags authorized under this subsection shall be determined
- 24 by agreement between the State Tax Commission and the governing
- 25 authorities of public universities in the states where the
- 26 universities are located. Such other design characteristics and
- 27 information to be contained on such distinctive license tags shall
- 28 be determined by the State Tax Commission.
- 29 (c) Application for the distinctive license tag
- 30 authorized under this subsection shall be made to the county tax

- 31 collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The
- 32 application and the additional fee, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be
- 33 retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax
- 34 Commission within seven (7) days of the date that the application
- 35 is made. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax
- 36 collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- 37 (d) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees
- 38 that it receives under this subsection into the State Treasury on
- 39 the day received. At the end of each month, the State Tax
- 40 Commission shall certify the total fees collected under this
- 41 section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute such
- 42 collections as follows:
- 43 (i) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the additional
- 44 fees collected from each distinctive license tag issued under this
- 45 subsection shall be distributed to the World War II Veterans
- 46 Memorial in Washington, D.C. However, when the amounts
- 47 distributed to the World War II Veterans Memorial reaches an
- 48 aggregate amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00),
- 49 then Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of such additional fees shall be
- 50 deposited into the State General Fund.
- 51 (ii) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee
- 52 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 53 section shall be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's
- 54 Memorial Burn Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- 55 (iii) <u>Twenty-two Dollars (\$22.00)</u> of each
- 56 additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued
- 57 pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the credit of the
- 58 State Highway Fund to be expended solely for the repair,
- 59 maintenance, construction or reconstruction of highways.
- 60 (2) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 61 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 62 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 63 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under

- 64 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 65 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 66 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 67 tag.
- 68 (3) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 69 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 70 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 71 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 72 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 73 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 74 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 75 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 76 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 77 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 78 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after July 1, 2001.
