- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WRITTEN PRESCRIPTIONS FOR EYEGLASSES
- AND CONTACT LENSES ISSUED TO INDIVIDUALS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER
- 3 DO NOT EXPIRE AND MAY BE FILLED BY ANY AUTHORIZED PRACTITIONER
- 4 REGARDLESS OF WHEN THE PRESCRIPTION WAS WRITTEN; AND FOR RELATED
- 5 PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. A written prescription by a licensed
- ophthalmologist or optometrist for corrective lens for eyesight, 8
- 9 including eyeglasses and contact lenses, that is issued to an
- individual who is age eighteen (18) or older when the prescription 10
- is written, does not expire and is valid indefinitely. Any 11
- practitioner who is legally authorized to fill a prescription for 12
- corrective lenses may fill any such prescription regardless of the 13
- 14 date on which the prescription was written.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 15
- 16 and after July 1, 2001.

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
