## HOUSE BILL NO. 664

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-57-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REVISE CERTAIN STANDARDS CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF THE 2 3 LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM AND COMPRESSED GAS INDUSTRY; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 75-57-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 75-57-9. The codes of the American Society of Mechanical 8 9 Engineers - Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code - Section II Material Specifications; Section VIII Pressure Vessels; and Section IX 10 Welding and Brazing Qualifications; American Petroleum Institute 11 Standard 620 (American Petroleum Institute Recommended Rules for 12 the Design and Construction of Large Welded Low-pressure Storage 13 Tanks); Standards of the National Fuel Gas Code as published by 14 the National Fire Protection Association, NFPA-54; the Standards 15 for the Storage and Handling of Liquefied Petroleum Gas as 16 published by the National Fire Protection Association, NFPA-58; 17 and other National Fire Protection Association standards 18 applicable to liquefied petroleum gas and compressed gas; and the 19 safety requirements for the storage and handling of anhydrous 20 ammonia as published by the American National Standards Institute, 21 Inc.; as the codes and standards referred to herein as revised, 22 and standards referred to above are hereby adopted by reference as 23 specifications for the purpose of material standards, 24 construction, handling, transportation and installation of all 25 26 liquefied compressed gas systems and inspection and operation of pressure vessels. Copies of all codes and standards referred to 27

in the foregoing are available for public use and inspection at

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29	the office of the Commissioner of Insurance. The State Liquefied
30	Compressed Gas Board is fully authorized and empowered in the
31	exercise of its authority granted under this section to change,
32	delete from or amend from time to time the national code and
33	standards adopted by reference in this section. Any changes,
34	deletions or amendments made to the national codes and codes
35	adopted by reference in this section shall be made in strict
36	compliance with the Mississippi Administrative Procedures Law,
37	Chapter 43, Title 25, Mississippi Code of 1972, and with the
38	approval of the Commissioner of Insurance. The State Liquefied
39	Compressed Gas Board is fully authorized and empowered in the
40	exercise of the authority granted under this section to exempt or
41	grant deviations from the national code and standards adopted by
42	reference in this section with respect to reconditioned or
43	remanufactured railroad tank car pressure vessels designed for and
44	used as stationary storage tanks for agricultural fertilizers.
45	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
46	and after July 1, 2001.
