HOUSE BILL NO. 713

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-61-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
EXEMPT GOVERNMENTAL AND INVESTIGATIVE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES
CONDUCTING CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECKS FROM FEES ESTABLISHED FOR COSTS
INCIDENT TO PROVIDING RECORDS UNDER THE OPEN RECORDS ACT; AND FOR
RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 25-61-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8 amended as follows:

25-61-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this 9 subsection and in subsection (2) of this section, each public body 10 may establish and collect fees reasonably calculated to reimburse 11 it for, and in no case to exceed, the actual cost of searching, 12 reviewing and/or duplicating and, if applicable, mailing copies of 13 14 public records. However, a governmental or investigative law enforcement agency that is conducting a criminal records check is 15 exempt from any fees established under this subsection. Such fees 16 shall be collected by the public body in advance of complying with 17 the request. 18

A public body may establish a standard fee scale to 19 (2)reimburse it for the costs of creating, acquiring and maintaining 20 a geographic information system or multipurpose cadastre, as 21 22 authorized and defined under the Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983, or any other electronically accessible data. Such fees must 23 be reasonably related to the cost of creating, acquiring and 24 maintaining the geographic information system, multipurpose 25 cadastre or other electronically accessible data, for the data or 26 27 information contained therein or taken therefrom, and for any records, papers, accounts, maps, photographs, films, cards, tapes, 28

29 recordings or other materials, data or information relating 30 thereto, whether in printed, digital or other format. In 31 determining the fees or charges under this subsection, the public 32 body may consider the type of information requested, the purpose 33 or purposes for which the information has been requested and the 34 commercial value of the information.

35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2001.
