AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE 1 AND ADMINISTRATION TO REAUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF STATE GENERAL 2 FUNDS AND SPECIAL FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR CONSTRUCTION 3 AND/OR REPAIR AND RENOVATION PROJECTS AT VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES AND INSTITUTIONS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 8 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, 10 Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of 11 reauthorizing the expenditure of State General Funds, as 12 authorized in Senate Bill No. 3199, Regular Session of 1995, 13 Senate Bill No. 2503, Regular Session of 1996, Senate Bill No. 14 2427, Regular Session of 1997, House Bill No. 1684, Regular 15 Session of 1998, House Bill No. 1331, Regular Session of 1999, and 16 House Bill 834, Regular Session of 2000, for the fiscal year 17 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 18 19 .....\$ 66,550.00 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing 20 21 the expenditure of State General Funds for renovating and/or 22 repairing existing state-owned facilities and for purchasing and/or replacing furniture and equipment for all institutions, 23 agencies and departments of the State of Mississippi. 24 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 25 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 26 27 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2001, or change the 28 purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

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SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 29 30 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of Fund No. 3931, to the Department of 31 32 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, 33 Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of 34 reauthorizing the expenditure of funds previously appropriated for construction and/or repair and renovation projects at various 35 state agencies and institutions, for the fiscal year beginning 36 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 37 38 .....\$ 33,984,400.00.

This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of special funds for construction and/or repair and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions that had been authorized by the Legislature in prior fiscal years. Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the

44 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 45 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2001, or change the 46 purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

SECTION 3. 65 SECTION 4. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 66 Management of the Office of General Services is hereby expressly 67 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state, 68 local or other source funds designated for supplemental funding of 69 construction and/or repair and renovation projects.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 70 71 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 72 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 73 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 74 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 75 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 and after July 1, 2001. 77
