HOUSE BILL NO. 733

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-95, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL TO USE BRILL AND CAST NETS GREATER 2 THAN TWELVE FEET IN RADIUS IN THE MARINE WATERS OF THE STATE OF 3 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-95, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 49-15-95. (1) It is <u>unlawful</u> to use brill and cast nets 8 9 greater than twelve (12) feet * * * in radius in the marine waters of the State of Mississippi. 10 The commission shall not prohibit the use of brill and 11 (2) cast nets in the waters designated in subsection (1) of this 12 section whether or not such waters shall be determined as fresh or 13 salt waters. No person shall catch more than fifty (50) pounds of 14 shrimp per day using brill and cast nets as provided by this 15 16 section.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18 and after July 1, 2001.
