HOUSE BILL NO. 798

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN INFORMATION CONCERNING 1 CONSERVATION PLANS COLLECTED BY THE MISSISSIPPI SOIL AND WATER 2 3 CONSERVATION COMMISSION IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC RECORDS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this 6 section, information collected by the Mississippi Soil and Water 7 Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as "commission", 8 9 or a conservation district is not subject to the Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983 and may not be disclosed if the 10 information is collected in response to a specific request from a 11 landowner or the landowner's agent or tenant for technical 12 assistance relating to a water quality management plan or other 13 conservation plan if this assistance is to be provided on private 14 15 land that: Is part of a conservation plan or water quality 16 (a) management plan developed cooperatively with the commission or 17 conservation district; or 18 Is the subject of a report prepared by the (b) 19 commission or conservation district. 20 The commission or a conservation district may disclose (2) 21 information regarding a tract of land to: 22 The owner of the tract or the owner's agent or 23 (a) tenant; and 24 A person other than the owner or the owner's agent 25 (b) 26 or tenant if:

(i) The owner or the agent or tenant consents in
writing to full or specified partial disclosure of the
information; and

30 (ii) The consent is attached to each plan or
31 report regarding the tract prepared by the commission or local
32 conservation district.

33 (3) The commission or a conservation district may disclose, 34 in a manner that prevents the identification of a particular tract 35 of land, the owner of the tract or the owner's agent or tenant, a 36 summary of information collected by the commission or local 37 conservation district regarding:

38 (a) The number of acres of land that are in a39 particular conservation plan;

40 (b) The number of acres of land that are subject to a41 particular conservation practice; or

(c) Other conservation program information.

(4) The commission or a conservation district shall provide
a person with notice regarding this section at the time the person
requests technical assistance from the commission or conservation
district.

(5) The commission or a conservation district may disclose 47 48 information to a law enforcement agency of this state or the United States in compliance with a subpoena for the information. 49 (6) The commission or a conservation district may disclose 50 51 information relating to water quality complaints or compliance failures to the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality. 52 53 (7) The commission or a conservation district may disclose

54 to the attorney general information relating to a breach of 55 contract.

56 (8) The commission or a conservation district may not be 57 held liable for damage caused by a violation of this section.
