HOUSE BILL NO. 818

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-37-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 EXTEND THE DATE THAT THE STATEWIDE SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION 2 MANAGEMENT SYSTEM STRATEGIC PLAN IS DUE TO BE DEVELOPED AND 3 PREPARED FROM OCTOBER 1, 2001, TO OCTOBER 1, 2002; AND FOR RELATED 4 5 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 49-37-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 49-37-9. (1) Before October 1, 2002, the Mississippi 9 10 Scientific Information Management System Coordinating Council 11 shall develop and prepare a strategic plan for the development and 12 implementation of a statewide scientific information management 13 system. The strategic plan shall include, but not be limited to, 14 (2)the following: 15 (a) A detailed analysis of the sources, types, amounts 16 17 and methods by which scientific information is currently collected 18 in the state and of methods or systems currently used to manage that scientific information; 19 An identification of the current costs of 20 (b) collection, management, analysis, updating, use and dissemination 21 22 of scientific information in the state with particular emphasis on costs to state agencies; 23 A description of current efforts by agencies and 24 (C) 25 organizations collecting scientific information to provide broad access to that information; 26 (d) An identification of planned scientific information 27 management programs and needs and an evaluation of how those 28 *HR40/R1310* H. 29 planned programs or needs may be met or integrated into the 30 statewide scientific information management system; 31 (e) A clearly-defined, comprehensive statement of the 32 mission, goals and objectives of the statewide scientific 33 information management system; 34 (f) A detailed analysis of the benefits and capabilities of a statewide scientific information management 35 36 system; A plan for the development and implementation of a 37 (g) 38 statewide scientific information management system in a phased 39 manner; A timeline for the development and implementation 40 (h) 41 of a statewide scientific information management system; A detailed analysis and estimate of the costs for 42 (i) development and implementation of the statewide scientific 43 information management system and a recommended method for funding 44 45 the development and implementation of the system; and 46 (j) Any other information the coordinating council 47 deems appropriate. 48 In addition, the strategic plan shall recommend (3) 49 appropriate policies and standards for use in management of 50 scientific information and for providing access to that The strategic plan shall also address information 51 information. accuracy and quality issues, ease of access issues, training and 52 53 technical support issues and interagency coordination issues. 54 (4) Upon completion of the strategic plan, the coordinating 55 council shall provide copies to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the 56 57 Chairmen of the Senate Environmental Protection, Conservation and Water Resources Committee and the Senate Appropriations Committee, 58 59 the Chairmen of the House Conservation and Water Resources 60 Committee and the House Appropriations Committee, the Legislative
