HOUSE BILL NO. 862

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-80, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,

2 TO REQUIRE SEPARATE ANNUAL COMMERCIAL GIG FISHING LICENSES FOR

3 VESSELS AND INDIVIDUALS ENGAGED IN COMMERCIAL GIG FISHING; AND FOR

4 RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-80, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

7 amended as follows:

8 49-15-80. (1) (a) All vessels to be used in catching or

9 transporting fish in the waters of the State of Mississippi for

10 commercial purposes shall, before beginning operations, obtain an

11 annual license from the commission and pay a license fee according

12 to the following schedule:

13 (i) All resident vessels engaged in commercial

14 hook and line fishing shall be issued a separate annual license by

15 the commission at a fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). All

16 nonresident vessels engaged in commercial hook and line fishing

17 shall be issued a separate annual license by the commission at a

18 fee of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00). Each individual engaged in

19 commercial hook and line fishing must obtain a commercial hook and

20 line fisherman license <u>subject to</u> the following license fees: One

21 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a resident commercial hook and line

22 fisherman license; or Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) for a

23 nonresident commercial hook and line fisherman license. If a duly

24 licensed commercial hook and line vessel is engaged in commercial

25 fishing, each individual aboard must possess a commercial hook and

26 line fisherman license.

- 27 (ii) A resident fee of One Hundred Dollars
- 28 (\$100.00) or a nonresident fee of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00),
- 29 on boats using trammel nets, gill nets or seines not more than one
- 30 thousand two hundred (1,200) feet in length.
- 31 (iii) All resident vessels engaged in commercial
- 32 gig fishing shall be issued a separate annual license by the
- 33 commission at a fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). All
- 34 nonresident vessels engaged in commercial gig fishing shall be
- 35 issued a separate annual license by the commission at a fee of
- 36 Four Hundred dollars (\$400.00). Each individual engaged in
- 37 commercial gig fishing must obtain a commercial gig fisherman
- 38 license subject to the following license fees: resident
- 39 commercial gig fisherman license, One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 40 Nonresident commercial gig fisherman license, Four Hundred Dollars
- 41 (\$400.00). If a duly licensed commercial gig fishing vessel is
- 42 engaged in commercial fishing, each individual aboard must possess
- 43 a commercial gig fisherman license.
- (b) Beginning September 15, 1994, no nonresident shall
- 45 be issued a commercial fishing license under this chapter for the
- 46 taking of fish using any type of net if that nonresident's state
- 47 of domicile prohibits the issuing of commercial fishing licenses
- 48 to residents of this state to engage in like activity.
- 49 (2) Each factory or manufacturing establishment engaging in
- 50 the manufacture of oil, fish scrap, fish meal, fertilizer or other
- 51 products from menhaden, shall pay a license fee of Five Hundred
- 52 Dollars (\$500.00).
- 53 (3) Each boat or vessel engaging in the catching, taking or
- 54 transporting menhaden in the waters of the State of Mississippi,
- 55 the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and shall pay Fifty
- 56 Dollars (\$50.00) on each net, seine, trawl or purse net used in
- 57 catching or taking menhaden in the waters of the State of
- 58 Mississippi.

59 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

60 and after July 1, 2001.
