HOUSE BILL NO. 875

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 DELETE THE SALARIES OF THE CLERK OF THE SUPREME COURT AND STATE
3 LAW LIBRARIAN FROM THE OMNIBUS PAY SECTION; TO AMEND SECTIONS
4 9-3-14 AND 39-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE
5 SUPREME COURT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE CLERK AND STATE LAW
6 LIBRARIAN; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. Section 25-3-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:

10 25-3-33. The annual salaries of the following appointive

141 SECTION 2. Section 9-3-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 142 amended as follows:

143 9-3-14. The Clerk of the Supreme Court shall be appointed by
 144 majority vote of the Supreme Court and shall serve at the pleasure
 145 of the court. The Supreme Court shall fix the compensation of the
 146 Clerk of the Supreme Court, subject to the approval of the State
 147 Personnel Board.

148 SECTION 3. Section 39-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 149 amended as follows:

150 39-1-1. (1) There shall be a State Library which shall
 151 render law library services to the Supreme Court and other state
 152 courts, to state officials and to the general public.

153 (2) The State Library shall be under the supervision and
 154 control of the Mississippi Supreme Court, and the court shall be
 155 empowered to promulgate policies and procedures necessary for the
 156 efficient operation of the Library.

157 (3) The Supreme Court shall fix the compensation of the
 158 State Law Librarian, subject to the approval of the State
 159 Personnel Board.

160 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
 161 and after July 1, 2001.
