HOUSE BILL NO. 905 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REVISE PENALTIES FOR THREATENING OR HARASSING PHONE CALLS; AND 2 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-29-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 7 97-29-45. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or 8 persons: To make any comment, request, suggestion or 9 (a) proposal over a telephone which is obscene, lewd or lascivious 10 with intent to abuse, threaten or harass any party to a telephone 11 12 conversation; (b) To make a telephone call, with intent to terrify, 13 intimidate or harass, and threaten to inflict injury or physical 14 harm to any person at the called number or to his property; 15 16 (c) To make a telephone call, whether or not 17 conversation ensues, without disclosing his identity and with 18 intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any person at the 19 called number; (d) To make or cause the telephone of another 20 21 repeatedly or continuously to ring, with intent to harass any person at the called number; 22 23 (e) To make repeated telephone calls, during which conversation ensues, solely to harass any person at the called 24 25 number; or 26 (f) Knowingly to permit any telephone under his control to be used for any purpose prohibited by this section. 27 *HR40/R1306SG* H. 28 Upon conviction of any person for the first offense of (2) violating subsection (1) of this section, such person shall be 29 fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned 30 in the county jail for not more than six (6) months, or both. 31 32 (3) Upon conviction of any person for the second offense of 33 violating subsection (1) of this section, the offenses being committed within a period of five (5) years, such person shall be 34 fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned 35 in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or both. 36 (4) For any third or subsequent conviction of any person 37 38 violating subsection (1) of this section, the offenses being committed within a period of five (5) years, such person shall be 39 40 guilty of a felony and fined not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) and/or imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for not 41 more than two (2) years, or both. 42 (5) The provisions of this section do not apply to a person 43 or persons who make a telephone call that would be covered by the 44 provisions of the federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, 15 45 USCS Section 1692 et seq. 46 47 (6) * * * Any person violating this section may be prosecuted in the county where the telephone call, conversation or 48 49 language originates in case such call, conversation or language originates in the State of Mississippi. In case the call, 50 51 conversation or language originates outside of the State of 52 Mississippi then such person shall be prosecuted in the county to which it is transmitted. 53 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 54 55 and after July 1, 2001.
