COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 964

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-33-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE SHALL PAY THE FULL COSTS FOR INSPECTION 3 SERVICES OF QUAIL AND RABBIT PROCESSING PLANTS; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 75-33-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 75-33-33. Any person desiring inspection service over and above the inspection service normally provided by the commissioner 9 10 for sanitary purposes, and any person desiring a grading service as authorized by this article, shall pay the commissioner for such 11 12 services. The person requesting such services shall pay the 13 commissioner a sum sufficient to cover the salary or wages of the inspector, or the grader, plus necessary travel and other 14 15 authorized expenses, and a reasonable sum for administration expenses. All expenses to be paid hereunder shall be that sum 16 17 agreed upon with the commissioner.

The commissioner is hereby authorized and empowered to 18 19 recognize and accept any bona fide agreements and arrangements now 20 in existence, or that may hereafter be made, between any person 21 carrying on any business covered by this article and the proper officials of any county and/or municipality wherein local 22 inspection service is to be provided by the county or the 23 24 municipality as a condition or covenant to the establishing or 25 operating of such business. The commissioner may, in his 26 discretion, enter into an agreement with the appropriate agency of 27 the United States Department of Agriculture to receive financial

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assistance therefrom in helping carry out the purpose of this article, and to pay a reasonable state-matching contribution as may be required.

The commissioner shall inspect for wholesomeness all plants 31 32 in operation which are not under federal inspection. Except as 33 otherwise provided herein, the state shall pay the full costs for 34 such inspection after September 1, 1968. After July 1, 2001, the state shall pay the full costs for such inspection services of 35 quail and rabbit processing plants. Provided that so long as 36 37 funds are available which have been appropriated by the 38 Legislature for product inspection, the commissioner may employ and train inspection personnel and assign such personnel to plants 39 40 for inspection for wholesomeness. No state funds shall be used 41 for payment of overtime or for grading. Except as otherwise provided herein for inspection services of quail and rabbits, 42 plant management shall reimburse the Mississippi Department of 43 44 Agriculture and Commerce for inspection services of \* \* \* ratites and other exotic animals that are not regulated by mandate under 45 the Federal Meat Inspection Act or the Federal Poultry Products 46 47 Plants requesting such services must make Inspection Act. application for voluntary inspection services and obtain an 48 49 establishment "V" number.

50 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 51 and after July 1, 2001.
