HOUSE BILL NO. 1015  
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE TREASURER TO TRANSFER CERTAIN  
2 FUNDS INTO THE BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The State Treasurer shall transfer to the Budget  
5 Contingency Fund created in Senate Bill No. 2680, 2001 Regular  
6 Session, out of the following enumerated special funds, amounts  
7 listed below for each special fund throughout the period beginning  
8 upon passage of this act and through June 30, 2001:

24 The State Treasurer shall transfer the sum of Eight Hundred  
25 Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00) from the State General Funds  
26 appropriated for the support of the Mississippi Death Penalty

27           Defense Litigation Act in House Bill No. 1617, Chapter 24,  
28 Laws of 2000, not later than June 30, 2001.

29           The State Treasurer shall transfer the sum of Thirty-two  
30 Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$32,200,000.00) from the  
31 State General Fund not later than November 1, 2001.

32           The General Funds transferred under this section have been  
33 made available for transfer to the Budget Contingency Fund through  
34 reductions in various budgets below the level of the Joint  
35 Legislative Budget Committee recommendation for Fiscal Year 2002  
36 and have been utilized to support certain nonrecurring funding  
37 needs which exceed the level of funding set forth within the Joint  
38 Legislative Budget Committee recommendation for Fiscal Year 2002.

39           In addition to the amounts transferred to the Budget  
40 Contingency Fund under the provisions of this act, the Budget  
41 Contingency Fund is hereby authorized to receive any additional  
42 funds that may become available to the fund from any source during  
43 Fiscal Year 2002.

44           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
45 and after its passage.
