HOUSE BILL NO. 1019

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-21-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO TEST FOR CONGENITAL 2 ADRENAL HYPERPLASIA (CAH) AS PART OF ITS NEWBORN SCREENING 3 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 41-21-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 7 41-21-201. The State Department of Health is * * * 8 authorized to establish, maintain and carry out a newborn 9 10 screening program designed to detect hypothyroidism, 11 phenylketonuria (PKU), hemoglobinopathy, congenital adrenal hyperplasia (CAH) and galactosemia which may result in mental 12 13 retardation or medical complications in children. The State Board of Health is authorized to adopt rules and regulations necessary 14 15 to accomplish the program. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 16

17 and after July 1, 2001.
