1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE MISSISSIPPI FORESTRY COMMISSION, TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN STATE OWNED REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN WINSTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Finance and
7	Administration, acting on behalf of the Mississippi Forestry
8	Commission, upon meeting the requirements of Section 29-1-1, may
9	sell and convey certain state owned real property and the
10	improvements thereon located in Winston County, Mississippi, being
11	more particularly described as follows:
12	Commence at the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 34,
13	Township 13 North, Range 10 East, and run North 1,713.64
14	feet; thence West 1,226.75 feet to the point of
15	beginning; thence North 85 degrees 48 minutes East 147.5
16	feet; thence North 4 degrees 12 minutes West 147.5 feet;
17	thence South 85 degrees 48 minutes West 147.5 feet;
18	thence South 4 degrees 12 minutes East 147.5 feet to the
19	point of beginning. Containing 1/2 acre in the SW part
20	of the NE $1/4$ of the NE $1/4$ of Section 34, Township 13
21	North, Range 10 East.
22	The Department of Finance and Administration may have the parcel
23	of property surveyed.

(2) The real property and the improvements thereon described

in subsection (1) of this section shall be sold for not less than

the current fair market value as determined by the averaging of at

least two (2) appraisals by qualified appraisers who shall be

- 28 selected by the Department of Finance and Administration and shall
- 29 be certified and licensed by the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser
- 30 Licensing and Certification Board.
- 31 (3) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights
- 32 to the real property sold and conveyed under this section.
- 33 (4) The proceeds from the sale and conveyance of the real
- 34 property and improvements thereon described in subsection (1) of
- 35 this section shall be used by the Mississippi Forestry Commission
- 36 to escalate its budget in the Other Than Equipment category for
- 37 the purchase of real estate to be used by the Mississippi Forestry
- 38 Commission in the performance of its powers and duties.
- 39 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after its passage.
