HOUSE BILL NO. 1058

- AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION THAT AUTHORIZES GOVERNING 1 AUTHORITIES OF MUNICIPALITIES TO ESTABLISH AN EMPLOYER-ASSISTED 2 HOUSING PROGRAM TO ASSIST EMPLOYEES WHEN PURCHASING A HOME WITHIN 3 THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. (1) There is established the Mississippi
- 7 Employer-Assisted Housing Program for Municipal Employees, which
- 8 shall be a special home loan program for eligible full-time
- employees. The home loan program shall be administered by the 9
- 10 governing authorities of municipalities in conjunction with the
- 11 Federal National Mortgage Association (Fannie Mae). The governing
- authorities may contract with one or more public or private 12
- 13 entities to provide assistance in implementing and administering
- 14 the program and shall adopt rules and regulations regarding the
- 15 implementation and administration of the program.
- (2) Participation in the loan program shall be available to 16
- 17 any eligible municipal employee as determined by the governing
- authorities of the municipality. Any person who receives a loan 18
- under the program shall be required to purchase a house and reside 19
- 20 within the geographic boundaries as determined by the governing
- authorities of the municipality. The maximum amount of a loan 21
- 22 that may be made under the program to any person shall be Six
- Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00). 23
- 24 (3) Any loan made under the program to a municipal employee
- 25 shall be converted to an interest-free grant on the basis of one
- (1) year's employment for one-third (1/3) of the amount of the 26
- 27 loan. Any person who does not render three (3) years' service as

- 28 a municipal employee shall be liable to the municipality for
- one-third (1/3) of the amount of the loan for each year that he is
- 30 not employed, plus interest accruing at the current interest rate
- 31 at the time the person discontinues his employment. If a claim
- 32 for repayment under this subsection is placed in the hands of an
- 33 attorney for collection, the obligor shall be liable for an
- 34 additional amount equal to a reasonable attorney's fee.
- 35 (4) All funds received by the governing authorities of the
- 36 municipality as repayment of loans by program participants shall
- 37 be deposited in the Mississippi Employer-Assisted Housing Program
- 38 for Municipal Employees Fund.
- 39 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified in Title
- 40 21, Chapter 17, of the Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 41 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2001.
