HOUSE BILL NO. 1065

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-7-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT THE HEADLIGHTS OF VEHICLES SHALL BE OPERATED WHENEVER 2 CONDITIONS NECESSITATE THE USE OF WINDSHIELD WIPERS; TO PROHIBIT 3 THE USE OF ONLY THE PARKING LIGHTS OF VEHICLES DURING TIMES WHEN 4 THE USE OF HEADLIGHTS IS REQUIRED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-7-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 63-7-11. Every vehicle operated upon a public road, street 9 or highway within this state * * * shall be equipped with lighted 10 11 front and rear lamps as respectively required in Section 63-7-13 12 for different classes of vehicles and subject to exemption with 13 reference to lights on parked vehicles as hereinafter stated in this chapter, and such front and rear lamps shall be operated on 14 every such vehicle during the following times: 15 The period from sunset to sunrise; and 16 (a) 17 (b) Whenever precipitation or any other condition 18 necessitates the use of windshield wipers by vehicle operators. It is unlawful for any vehicle operator to use only the 19 parking lights or auxiliary driving lamps of the vehicle during 20 any time when this section requires the use of the front and rear 21 22 lamps of the vehicle. Any person violating the provisions of this section, upon 23 24 conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than 25 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 27 and after July 1, 2001.
