HOUSE BILL NO. 1068

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REVISE THE DISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY FUNDS MATCHED BY 2 THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CERTAIN COUNTIES 3 THAT ARE TO BE EXPENDED ON FEDERAL AID ROUTES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY 4 SYSTEM AND IN THE COUNTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 65-9-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 65-9-29. (1) Federal aid highway funds allocated to 9 Mississippi and to be expended on the federal aid routes shall be 10 11 expended as follows: 12 (a) * * * Federal aid * * * funds allocated to Mississippi and to be expended on the federal aid routes shall be 13 14 divided between the Mississippi Department of Transportation and the several counties, so that fifty percent (50%) will be matched 15 by the Mississippi Department of Transportation and expended on 16 17 the federal aid routes on the state highway system, and fifty 18 percent (50%) matched by the counties with state aid or local funds and expended on the federal aid routes in the several 19 20 counties. 21 (b) Such division will be made upon allocation by the Division Administrator of the Federal Highway Administration 22 * * *. The expenditure of all federal * * * funds shall be 23 through and under the * * * department, subject to and in 24 25 accordance with all rules and regulations and applicable laws of the federal government. 26 27 (c) Not less than fifty percent (50%) of the funds appropriated to Mississippi under the STP authorization of Public 28 *HR40/R1621* H. 29 Law 105-178, the Transportation Equity Act for the twenty-first 30 century (TEA-21) allocated for the substate distribution any area 31 of the state and fifty percent(50%) of the amount allocated to areas with a population less than five thousand (5,000) shall be 32 33 allocated to the eighty-two (82) counties and administered by the 34 Office of State Aid Road Construction. 35 * * * (d) Not less that thirty percent (30%) of the bridge 36 replacement funds allocated to Mississippi under TEA-21 shall be 37 allocated to the eighty-two (82) counties to replace deficient 38 39 bridges in accordance with all rules and regulation of the federal 40 highway administration and administered by the Office of State Aid 41 Road Construction. * * * 42 Federal aid * * * highway funds allocated to 43 (2) Mississippi, * * * including federal bridge replacement funds and 44 45 other special grants made available for expenditure of county 46 roads, shall be expended as follows: (a) Federal aid off-system highway funds expended on 47 48 state aid roads shall be matched with available state aid funds 49 and/or other available local funds, or as otherwise provided in 50 Section 65-1-70. Federal aid off-system highway funds available for 51 (b) 52 expenditure on roads not on the state aid system and not eligible 53 for inclusion on the state aid system shall be matched with available local funds, or as otherwise provided in Section 65-9-17 54 or Section 65-1-70. 55 The expenditure of all federal off-system highway 56 (C) 57 funds on county roads shall be programmed by the State Highway Commission, subject to and in accordance with applicable federal 58 law, rules and regulations, and limited to such county projects as 59 60 recommended by the State Aid Engineer. 63 requirements in the same manner and under the same provisions and

64 conditions as other projects authorized under this chapter.

65 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 66 and after July 1, 2001.
