10	accommodations of a value less than <u>Two Hundred Fifty Dollars</u>
11	(\$250.00) at any hotel, motor hotel, motor lodge, inn,
12	boarding or eating house with intent to defraud the owner or
13	keeper thereof, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than
14	Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars
15	(\$500.00) or imprisoned in the county jail for a term not
16	exceeding one (1) year, or both; but any person who shall, for
17	himself or as the agent or representative of another or as an
18	officer of a corporation, obtain food, lodging, money, property or
19	other accommodations of a value of <u>Two Hundred Fifty Dollars</u>
20	(\$250.00) or over at any hotel, motor hotel, motor lodge,
