HOUSE BILL NO. 1131

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-7-64, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
REQUIRE THAT ONLY PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE YEARS MUST
WEAR A CRASH HELMET WHEN OPERATING OR RIDING A MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR
SCOOTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. Section 63-7-64, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

63-7-64. No person under the age of twenty-one (21) years 8 may operate or ride upon any motorcycle or motor scooter upon the 9 10 public roads or highways of this state unless such person is wearing on his or her head a crash helmet of the type and design 11 inspected and approved by the American Association of Motor 12 13 Vehicle Administrators. Violation of this section shall be deemed a violation of the traffic regulations and rules of the road and 14 15 punishable as provided by Section 63-9-11.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
