HOUSE BILL NO. 1147

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 69-5-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI FAIR COMMISSION TO ALLOW CERTAIN 3 ENTITIES TO USE, PUBLISH AND ADVERTISE IN CONNECTION WITH 4 ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED ON THE STATE FAIRGROUNDS FOR A MONETARY 5 CONSIDERATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 69-5-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

69-5-3. (1) The Mississippi Fair Commission shall set up 9 rules and regulations consistent with the law governing the 10 11 distribution of state monies for premiums or awards. It will be 12 the duty of the commission to meet at the call of the chairman, at 13 least twice each year, to approve premium lists or awards, and give out rules governing participants in state premium money in 14 Mississippi. Said commission may invite the presidents of the 15 various district livestock shows before said commission when 16 17 determining policies affecting district livestock shows.

18 (2) The Mississippi Fair Commission is hereby authorized to
19 accept money or funds donated to or to be awarded as prizes under
20 regulations promulgated by the commission.

(3) The Mississippi Fair Commission shall have charge of designated state lands and buildings, and have full power and authority in perfecting plans and causing to be held an agricultural and industrial exposition annually, and other events from time to time on said lands and located for the promotion of Mississippi agriculture and industry.

27 (4) The Mississippi Fair Commission is hereby authorized to
28 employ an attorney as prescribed in Section 69-1-14.
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The Mississippi Fair Commission may take any action 29 (5) authorized in Section 1 of Laws 2000, Chapter 306. 30 (6) The Mississippi Fair Commission may allow a commercial, 31 32 charitable or governmental concern to use, publish and advertise 33 such concern's name in connection with the State Fair, the Dixie National Livestock Show and Rodeo and any other activity conducted 34 on the state fairgrounds in return for a monetary consideration 35 paid to the commission, which funds shall be retained by the 36 commission and used for its operating expenses or for capital 37 improvements to the fairgrounds. 38 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 40 and after July 1, 2001.
