HOUSE BILL NO. 1187

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, 1 FISHERIES AND PARKS TO PERMIT STATE EMPLOYEES AND PERSONS 2 FIFTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO RECEIVE A FIFTY PERCENT 3 DISCOUNT ON CAMPING FEES CHARGED AT ALL STATE PARKS WITHIN THE 4 STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks may implement a program allowing (a) full-time 8 9 state employees, and (b) residents of Mississippi who are fifty-five (55) years of age or older to receive a fifty percent 10 (50%) discount on camping fees, golf green fees, cart rental fees 11 12 and any other fees charged at any state park within the State of Mississippi. The commission shall limit the period during which 13 14 discounts are offered for use of the particular facilities or equipment at each park to those months, days of the week and times 15 of the day when, as determined by the commission, the particular 16 17 facilities or equipment of that park customarily are less 18 congested and not subject to high volume use.

19 (2) In order to receive the fifty percent (50%) discount, a 20 prospective recipient must present satisfactory proof of full-time 21 employment with the state or age.

(a) Satisfactory proof of state employment includes an
identification card, badge, letter, certificate or other document
from the agency or department of the state by whom the worker is
employed, attesting that the worker is employed full-time by the
State of Mississippi.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries
 and Parks may promulgate rules and regulations as reasonably may
 be necessary and incidental to the efficient administration of
 this program.
 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
 and after July 1, 2001.
