HOUSE BILL NO. 1214

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT RACIAL PROFILING BY LAW ENFORCEMENT 2 OFFICERS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any law enforcement officer to detain or stop a person in traffic based solely on the 6 7 race of the person being detained or stopped. All law enforcement 8 agencies shall keep accurate records of all traffic stops and detentions identifying the reasons for the stops and the race of 9 the person being stopped or detained. Any law enforcement officer 10 who violates this section shall, upon conviction, be fined not 11 12 more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for up to one (1) year, or both. 13

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 15 and after July 1, 2001.
