HOUSE BILL NO. 1216

- AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 91-9-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 ALLOW TRUSTS TO TAKE TITLE TO REAL PROPERTY; AND FOR RELATED
- 3 PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 6 91-9-2, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 7 91-9-2. (1) All property originally brought into the trust
- 8 or subsequently acquired by purchase or otherwise, on account of
- 9 the trust, is trust property.
- 10 (2) Unless the contrary intention appears, property acquired
- 11 with trust funds is trust property.
- 12 (3) Any estate in real property may be acquired in the trust
- 13 name. Title so acquired can be conveyed only in the trust name.
- 14 (4) A conveyance to a trust in the trust name, though
- 15 without words of inheritance, passes the entire estate of the
- 16 grantor unless a contrary intent appears. This subsection (4)
- 17 shall apply to all conveyances to a trust in the trust name
- 18 heretofore made, provided, however, any person having a cause of
- 19 action, because of such conveyance as of July 1, 2001, may
- 20 commence suit on such cause of action within one (1) year of said
- 21 date, unless such cause of action be sooner barred by existing
- 22 law, and not afterwards.
- 23 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2001.
