## HOUSE BILL NO. 1288

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 2 27-19-56.32, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE 3 OF PERSONALIZED ANTIQUE AUTOMOBILE LICENSE PLATES; TO PRESCRIBE 4 FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSES; TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION 5 OF THE FEES COLLECTED FROM THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSE PLATES 6 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND; AND FOR RELATED 7 PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
9 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
10 27-19-56.32, Mississippi Code of 1972:

11 <u>27-19-56.32.</u> (1) Any citizen of the State of Mississippi 12 who owns a registered antique automobile may apply to the tax 13 collector in the county of his legal residence, on forms 14 prescribed by the State Tax Commission, for a personalized antique 15 automobile license tag to be displayed on such antique automobile.

(2) Upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad 16 valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for 17 18 private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other 19 noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (4) of this section, the 20 21 applicant shall be issued a personalized antique automobile license tag of the same color as regular license tags to consist 22 of not more than seven (7) letters of the alphabet or seven (7) 23 numbers in lieu of the license tag numbering system prescribed by 24 25 law. The purchaser of the personalized antique automobile license tag may choose the combination of such letters or numbers, but no 26 two (2) motor vehicles shall have the same combination of letters 27 28 or numbers. If the same combination of letters has been chosen by

two (2) or more purchasers, the State Tax Commission shall assign 29 30 a different number to each such purchaser which shall appear on 31 the license tag following the combination of letters; however, this combination shall not exceed seven (7) letters and/or 32 33 numbers. The combination of letters and/or numbers written across 34 the license tag shall be sufficiently large to be easily read but 35 shall not be less than three (3) inches in height. No combination 36 of letters or numbers which comprise words or expressions that are considered obscene, slandering, insulting or vulgar in ordinary 37 usage shall be permitted, with the Chairman of the State Tax 38 39 Commission having the responsibility of making such determination. If, however, such license plate is issued in error or otherwise 40 and is determined by the chairman to be obscene, slanderous, 41 insulting, vulgar or offensive, the chairman shall notify such 42 owner that the license plate must be surrendered and that another 43 personalized license plate may be selected by him and issued at no 44 45 cost. Should the vehicle owner not desire another personalized license plate, the fee for such plate shall be refunded. 46 If the owner fails to surrender the license plate after receiving proper 47 notification, the chairman shall issue an order directing that the 48 license plate be seized by agents of the State Tax Commission or 49 50 any other duly authorized law enforcement personnel. If the owner is aggrieved by this determination, the appeal procedure and the 51 provisions provided in Section 27-19-337 shall be followed. 52 53 Application for the personalized antique automobile (3)

license tags shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 54 55 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application form 56 shall contain space for the applicant to make five (5) different choices for the combination of the letters and numbers in the 57 order in which said combination is desired by the applicant. 58 The 59 application and the additional fee, less five percent (5%) thereof 60 to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the 61 State Tax Commission within seven (7) days of the date the \*HR03/R1457\*

H. B. No. 1288 01/HR03/R1457 PAGE 2 (JWB\LH) application is made. The portion of the additional fee retainedby the tax collector shall be deposited into the county generalfund.

65 (4) (a) Beginning with any registration year commencing on 66 or after July 1, 2001, any person applying for a personalized 67 antique automobile license tag shall pay an additional fee which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional 68 fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the 69 70 vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) is due and payable at the time the 71 72 original application is made for a personalized antique automobile license tag and thereafter annually at the time of renewal 73 74 registration as long as the owner retains the personalized tag. If the owner does not wish to retain such personalized tag, he 75 76 must surrender it to the local county tax collector. The 77 additional fee due at the time of renewal registration shall be 78 collected by the county tax collector and remitted to the State 79 Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission.

The State Tax Commission shall deposit all taxes 80 (b) 81 and fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify the total 82 83 fees collected under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute to the credit of the State General Fund Sixteen Dollars 84 and Twenty-five Cents (\$16.25) of each additional fee and the 85 86 remainder of each such additional fee shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund to be expended solely for the 87 88 repair, maintenance, construction or reconstruction of highways.

89 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 90 required by law until replaced by a personalized antique 91 automobile license tag; and the regular license tag must be 92 surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the personalized 93 license tag. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license

96 (6) The applicant shall receive a refund of the fee paid for 97 a personalized antique automobile license tag if the personalized 98 license tag is not issued to him because the combination of 99 letters and numbers requested to be placed thereon is not 100 available for any reason.

(7) In the case of loss or theft of a personalized antique 101 102 automobile license tag, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement license tag as provided by Section 103 104 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement personalized antique automobile license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax 105 106 collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be 107 entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the 108 remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from 109 the sale of regular license tags. 110

111 (8) For the purposes of this section, motor vehicles 112 manufactured more than twenty-five (25) years ago shall hereafter 113 be classified as antique automobiles.

114 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 115 and after July 1, 2001.
