## HOUSE BILL NO. 1306

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL FISHING IN THE PASCAGOULA RIVER SYSTEM; TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. (1) It is unlawful for any person, firm or
- 6 corporation to engage in commercial fishing in any connected or
- 7 nonconnected oxbow lake or tributary stream of the Pascagoula
- 8 River where the main channel of the Pascagoula River is bordered
- 9 by the Upper Pascagoula River Wildlife Management Area, the lower
- 10 Pascagoula River Wildlife Management Area or the Ward Bayou
- 11 Wildlife Management Area.
- 12 (2) Any person, firm or corporation that violates the
- 13 provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
- 14 conviction, shall be fined not less than Two Hundred Dollars
- 15 (\$200.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the
- 16 first offense; not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor
- 17 more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the second offense
- 18 when the second offense is committed within a period of three (3)
- 19 years after the date on which the first offense was committed; and
- 20 not less that Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) nor more than Four
- 21 Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00), or imprisonment in the county jail
- 22 for a period of not more than thirty (30) days for a third or
- 23 subsequent offense, when that offense is committed within a period
- 24 of three (3) years after the date on which the first offense was
- 25 committed.

- Any fine or sentence, or both, imposed upon a person for a second, third or subsequent offense under this section shall not be suspended or reduced.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
