## HOUSE BILL NO. 1328

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL 2 EXERCISE GENERAL SUPERVISION OVER THE CHARLOTTE CAPERS BUILDING 3 AND THE WILLIAM F. WINTER ARCHIVES AND HISTORY BUILDING; TO AMEND 4 SECTION 29-5-81, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE 5 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION 6 OVER THE CHARLOTTE CAPERS BUILDING AND THE WILLIAM F. WINTER 7 ARCHIVES AND HISTORY; TO AMEND SECTION 29-17-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE 8 OF 1972, TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "CAPITOL COMPLEX" TO 9 INCLUDE THE CHARLOTTE CAPERS BUILDING AND THE WILLIAM F. WINTER 10 11 ARCHIVES AND HISTORY BUILDING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 29-5-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 14 amended as follows:
- 15 29-5-2. The duties of the \* \* \* Department of Finance and
- 16 Administration shall be as follows:
- 17 (a) (i) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 18 and keep in good condition the following state property located in
- 19 the City of Jackson: the New State Capitol Building, the Woolfolk
- 20 State Office Building, the Carroll Gartin Justice Building, the
- 21 Walter Sillers Office Building, the War Veterans' Memorial
- 22 Building, the Charlotte Capers Building, the William F. Winter
- 23 Archives and History Building, the Ike Sanford Veterans Affairs
- 24 Building, the Old State Capitol Building, the Governor's Mansion,
- 25 the Heber Ladner Building, the Burroughs Building, the Robert E.
- 26 Lee Office Building, the Robert E. Lee Parking Garage, the Manship
- 27 House Restoration and Visitor Center, the State Records Center,
- 28 the 301 Lamar Street Building, and all other properties acquired
- 29 in the same transaction at the time of the purchase of the Robert
- 30 E. Lee Hotel property from the First Federal Savings and Loan

- 31 Association of Jackson, Mississippi, which properties are more
- 32 particularly described in a warranty deed heretofore executed and
- 33 delivered on April 22, 1969, and filed for record in the office of
- 34 the Chancery Clerk of the First Judicial District of Hinds County,
- 35 Mississippi, located in Jackson, Mississippi, on April 25, 1969,
- 36 at 9:00 a.m., and recorded in Deed Book No. 1822, page 136 et
- 37 seq., and the Central High Building and 101 Capitol Centre.
- 38 (ii) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 39 and keep in good condition the Dr. Eldon Langston Bolton Building
- 40 located in Biloxi, Mississippi.
- 41 (iii) To exercise general supervision and care
- 42 over and keep in good condition the State Service Center, located
- 43 at the intersection of State Highway 49 and John Merl Tatum
- 44 Industrial Drive in Hattiesburg, Mississippi.
- 45 (b) To assign suitable office space for the various
- 46 state departments, officers and employees who are provided with an
- 47 office in any of the buildings under the jurisdiction or control
- 48 of the Department of Finance and Administration. However, the
- 49 assignment of space in the New Capitol Building shall be
- 50 designated by duly passed resolution of the combined Senate Rules
- 51 Committee and the House Management Committee, meeting as a joint
- 52 committee, approved by the Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the
- 53 House of Representatives. A majority vote of the members of the
- 54 Senate Rules Committee and a majority vote of the members of the
- 55 House Management Committee shall be required on all actions taken,
- 56 resolutions or reports adopted, and all other matters considered
- 57 by the full combined committee on occasions when the Senate Rules
- 58 Committee and the House Management Committee shall meet as a full
- 59 combined committee.
- 60 (c) To approve or disapprove, and with the concurrence
- of the Public Procurement Review Board, any lease or rental
- 62 agreements by any state agency or department, including any state
- 63 agency financed entirely by federal and special funds, for space

- 64 outside the buildings under the jurisdiction of the Department of
- 65 Finance and Administration. In no event shall any employee,
- officer, department, federally funded agency or bureau of the
- 67 state be authorized to enter a lease or rental agreement without
- 68 prior approval of the Department of Finance and Administration and
- 69 the Public Procurement Review Board.
- 70 The Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to
- 71 use architects, engineers, building inspectors and other personnel
- 72 for the purpose of making inspections as may be deemed necessary
- 73 in carrying out its duties and maintaining the facilities.
- 74 (d) To acquire by lease, lease-purchase agreement, or
- 75 otherwise, as provided in Section 27-104-107, and to assign
- 76 through the Department of Finance and Administration, by lease or
- 77 sublease agreement from the department, and with the concurrence
- 78 of the Public Procurement Review Board, to any state agency or
- 79 department, including any state agency financed entirely by
- 80 federal and special funds, appropriate office space in the
- 81 buildings acquired.
- 82 SECTION 2. Section 29-5-81, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 83 amended as follows:
- 84 29-5-81. Grounds of public buildings over which the
- 85 Department of Finance and Administration has jurisdiction shall
- 86 comprise the following:
- 87 (a) In the City of Jackson, Mississippi:
- New State Capitol: Bounded on the north by High Street, on
- 89 the west by North West Street, on the south by Mississippi Street,
- 90 and on the east by North President Street;
- Governor's Mansion: Bounded on the north by Amite Street, on
- 92 the west by North West Street, on the south by Capitol Street and
- 93 on the east by North Congress Street;
- 94 Woolfolk State Office Building: Bounded on the north by High
- 95 Street, on the west by Lamar Street, on the south by Hamilton
- 96 Street and on the east by North West Street;

- 97 Old State Capitol and War Veterans' Memorial Building
- 98 Complex: Bounded on the north by Amite Street, on the west by
- 99 North State Street and South State Street, on the south by Pearl
- 100 Street and on the east by property of the Gulf, Mobile and Ohio
- 101 Railroad Company;
- 102 Carroll Gartin Justice Building and Walter Sillers Office
- 103 Building Complex: Bounded on the north by George Street, on the
- 104 west by North West Street, on the south by High Street and on the
- 105 east by North President Street;
- 106 Heber Ladner Building: Bounded on the north by Mississippi
- 107 Street, on the west by North Congress Street, on the south by the
- 108 property of Galloway Methodist Church used as a parking lot and on
- 109 the east by the property on which the Mississippi Farm Bureau
- 110 Federation Building stands;
- 111 State Board of Health Building: Bounded on the north by
- 112 Stadium Drive, on the west by the property of Mississippi Hospital
- 113 and Medical Service, on the southwest by property on which is
- 114 located a Standard Oil service station, on the southeast by
- 115 property leased by the Mississippi Federation of Women's Clubs and
- 116 on the east by North State Street;
- Robert E. Lee Building and other properties acquired in the
- 118 same transaction: Particularly described in warranty deed
- 119 executed and delivered on April 22, 1969, and filed for record in
- 120 the Office of the Chancery Clerk of the First Judicial District of
- 121 Hinds County, Mississippi, located in Jackson, Mississippi, on
- 122 April 25, 1969, at 9:00 a.m., and recorded in deed book No. 1822,
- 123 page 136, et seq.;
- 124 Charlotte Capers Building: Bounded on the north by the Old
- 125 Capitol Building, on the west by South State Street, on the south
- 126 by Pearl Street, and on the east by the Illinois Central Railroad
- 127 tracks;

- 128 William F. Winter Archives and History Building: Bounded on
- 129 the north by Mississippi Street, on the west by North Street, on
- 130 the south by Amite Street, and on the east by Jefferson Street;
- 131 Mayfair Building: Bounded on the north by George Street, on
- 132 the west by Northwest Street, on the south by Walter Sillers
- 133 Office Building complex, and on the east by North President
- 134 Street;
- 135 Court of Appeals Building: Bounded on the west by North
- 136 State Street, on the north by George Street, on the east by North
- 137 Street, and on the south by the building designated as 654 North
- 138 State Street, including the parking area east of and adjacent to
- 139 the 654 North State Street Building;
- 140 Central High Building;
- 141 101 Capitol Centre: Located at 101 West Capitol Street,
- 142 Jackson, Mississippi.
- 143 (b) The Dr. Eldon Langston Bolton Building: Located in
- 144 the City of Biloxi, Mississippi.
- 145 (c) The State Service Center: Located at the
- 146 intersection of State Highway 49 and John Merl Tatum Industrial
- 147 Drive in the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi.
- SECTION 3. Section 29-17-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 149 amended as follows:
- 150 29-17-1. As used in this chapter, the following words shall
- 151 have the meanings ascribed herein unless the context clearly
- 152 requires otherwise:
- 153 (a) "Public facility" shall mean any building or other
- 154 facility owned by the State of Mississippi, or by any agency,
- 155 department or political subdivision of the State of Mississippi,
- 156 which is occupied, used or under the control of the State of
- 157 Mississippi, or any agency or department of the State of
- 158 Mississippi, or any junior college district of the State of
- 159 Mississippi, or the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 160 Higher Learning of the State of Mississippi, or any institution

L61	under the jurisdiction of the Board of Trustees of State
L62	Institutions of Higher Learning of the State of Mississippi.
L63	(b) "Capitol complex" shall include the following state
L64	property located in Jackson, Mississippi: the New State Capitol
L65	Building, the Woolfolk State Office Building, the Carroll Gartin
L66	Justice Building, the Walter Sillers Office Building, the War
L67	Veterans' Memorial Building, the Charlotte Capers Building, the
L68	William F. Winter Archives and History Building, the Ike Sanford
L69	Veterans Affairs Building, the Old State Capitol Building, the
L70	Governor's Mansion, the Heber Ladner Building, the Burroughs
L71	Building, the Robert E. Lee Hotel Property, the Central High
L72	Legislative Services Building, the 301 Building or any other
L73	properties which may come under the supervision of the Department
L74	of Finance and Administration and are deemed to be in the Capitol
L75	Complex.
L76	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
L77	and after July 1, 2001.
