HOUSE BILL NO. 1572

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PEARL RIVER VALLEY WATER 2 SUPPLY DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2002. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available 8 to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year 9 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 10 11\$ 8,139,912.00. 12 However, funds derived from the special tax levy authorized under the provisions of Section 51-9-139, Mississippi Code of 13 1972, shall be expended only for principal of and interest on 14 bonds and shoreline development. 15 16 SECTION 2. 36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 45 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 act. 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 48 49 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 50 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 51 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 52 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 53 54 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 56 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

With the funds herein appropriated, funds are included and authorized in the Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits major object of expenditure to pay "call back pay" in lieu of "compensatory time credit," at the discretion of the Director of the Pearl River H. 63 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. Of the funds authorized and approved for 69 expenditure herein, it is the intention of the Legislature that 70 71 not less than twenty-five percent (25%) of all revenues obtained from the sale of timber on the Pearl River Valley Supply District 72 73 property shall be used for the promotion and enhancement of wildlife on the Pearl River Valley Supply District property. 74 The 75 promotion and enhancement of wildlife and the expenditure of these 76 funds shall be under the supervision of and at the discretion of the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. 77

SECTION 4. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

SECTION 5. The money herein approved for expenditure shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

89 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 90 and after July 1, 2001.

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
