5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much there	eof as may be

32	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of	
33	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to	
34	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal	
35	Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002	
36	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions	
37	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the	
38	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the	
39	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall	
40	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all	
41	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this	
42	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure	
43	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual	
44	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal	
45	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,	
46	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken

- 68 expend funds from any proceeds arising from participation in drug
- 69 seizure activities not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 70 (\$50,000.00), in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 71 Department of Finance and Administration.
- 72 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that with
- 73 the funds provided herein, overtime may be paid to PSC-Enforcement
- 74 Office Regulated Carrier positions, the PSC-Enforcement Officer
- 75 Chief position, PSC-Enforcement Officer District Supervisor
- 76 positions, PSC-Special Projects Officer IV position, and
- 77 PSC-Training Director position.
- 78 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 83 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 85 and after July 1, 2001.
