33 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 36 37 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 39 40 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 act. 44 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 46 47 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 48 49 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

56 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 58 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 61 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, Twenty-two 62 Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$22,216.00) is provided for 63 the Mississippi Fire Personnel Minimum Standards and Certification 64 Board.

SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 65 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 66 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Rural Fire Truck 67 Acquisition Fund to the Mississippi Department of Insurance for 68 the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance Program for the fiscal 69 70 year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002. 71 72 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 73 74 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 75 76 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 77 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 78 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 and after July 1, 2001.
