HOUSE BILL NO. 1600

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING
2 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE FOR THE
3 FISCAL YEAR 2002.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
7 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
8 Department of Insurance which is comprised of special source funds
9 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
10 purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
11 year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....
12 \$ 5,607,837.00.

13 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
14 Section 1 not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
15 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
16 expenditure:

33 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
36 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002
37 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the
39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
40 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
41 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
43 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
44 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal
46 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
47 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
48 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
49 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services"
50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

56 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
58 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

60 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
61 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, Twenty-two
62 Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$22,216.00) is provided for
63 the Mississippi Fire Personnel Minimum Standards and Certification
64 Board.

65 SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
66 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
67 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Rural Fire Truck
68 Acquisition Fund to the Mississippi Department of Insurance for
69 the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance Program for the fiscal
70 year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.
71 \$ 484,658.00.

72 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
73 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
74 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
75 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
76 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
77 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

78 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
79 and after July 1, 2001.
