AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE 2 FISCAL YEAR 2002; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 9 10 June 30, 2002..... \$ 6,159,742.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of 13 Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 14 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the 15 16 purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 17 18 2,774,702.00. 19 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, the following positions are 20 authorized: 21 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 22 23 Permanent: Full Time..... 146 24 Part Time..... 2.8 25 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 6 26 Part Time.... 5

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 27 28 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 29 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 30 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 31 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 32 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 33 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 34 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 35 36 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 37 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 38 39 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 40 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 41 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 42 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 43 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 44 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 45 46 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 47

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

50 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

54 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 55 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 56 57 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 58 operational costs of the department. regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 60 61 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

62 SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 63 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 64 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 65 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 66 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 67 Archives and History. 68

It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 69 SECTION 6. 70 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 71 72 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein 73 74 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local 75 76 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost 77 of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 78,972.00. 78

79 With the funds appropriated in this section, the following 80 positions are authorized:

81 Permanent: Full Time . . . . . . . . SECTION 8. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Six Hundred 82 Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) is provided to the Department of 83 84 Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help 85 86 support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

87 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is provided 88 for the purpose of supporting the Statewide Oral History Project 89 90 for Fiscal Year 2002.

91 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$650,000.00) 92 \*HR03/A475SG\* H. B. No. 1605 01/HR03/A475SG PAGE 3  $(\backslash)$ 

93 shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in94 Senate Bill No. 2680, 2001 Regular Session.

SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 96 97 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 98 99 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 100 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 101 and after July 1, 2001. 102
