HOUSE BILL NO. 1612

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF 1 EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND THE MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR 3 THE DEAF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2002. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board of 8 Education for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 9 10 Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for 11 the Deaf for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 12 June 30, 2002.....\$ 8,896,642.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 14 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 15 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Education for the support of the Mississippi School for the Blind 16 17 or the Mississippi School for the Deaf which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the 18 schools, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the schools 19 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 20 21 June 30, 2002.....\$ 964,052.00. SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 2.2 Section 1 and Section 2, the following positions are authorized: 23 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 24 25 Permanent: Full Time..... 202 26 Part Time.... 33 27 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 3

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29 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 30 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 31 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 32 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 33 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 34 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 35 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 36 37 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 38 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 39 act. 40 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 41 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 42 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 43 44 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 45 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 46 47 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 48 49 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by general law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein provided shall be expended to hire any person on a contractual basis, for any period for any purpose, without the express prior approval of the State Personnel Director. 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services, compliance with the State Compensation Plan and the
qualifications of the persons offering to perform the services.
The State Fiscal Officer shall not pay any warrant that is in
violation of this section.

65 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for 67 the Deaf shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this 68 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 69 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2001. The Department of 70 71 Finance and Administration shall insure that financial controls comparable to those utilized for Fiscal Year 2001 are maintained 72 73 throughout Fiscal Year 2002 for this agency. The State Personnel 74 Board shall insure that personnel controls and records comparable 75 to those utilized for Fiscal Year 2001 are maintained throughout Fiscal Year 2002 for this agency. It is further the intention of 76 77 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 78 2003 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 79 80 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request 81 process.

SECTION 5. With the funds provided herein, it is the intention of the Legislature that the academic teachers at the Mississippi School for the Deaf and the Mississippi School for the Blind shall receive their annual increment.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 86 87 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 88 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 89 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 90 91 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 92 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001. 93

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
