5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
10	\$ 36,996,100.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department
14	of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by
15	or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
18	\$ 151,724,987.00.
19	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
20	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
21	Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the

- 184 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven
- 185 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the
- 186 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs only and not for educational
- 187 purposes.
- 188 SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand
- 189 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Osteoporosis Program.
- 190 SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 191 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2001.
