HOUSE BILL NO. 1638

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE,  
2 FISHERIES AND PARKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING A FEASIBILITY  
3 STUDY ON CREATING A NATURAL AREA AND APPROPRIATE RECREATIONAL  
4 FACILITIES AT RED BLUFFS ON THE PEARL RIVER IN MARION COUNTY FOR  
5 THE FISCAL YEAR 2002.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be  
8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General  
9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Wildlife,  
10 Fisheries and Parks for the purpose of conducting a study of the  
11 feasibility of creating a natural area and appropriate  
12 recreational facilities at Red Bluffs on the Pearl River in Marion  
13 County, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending  
14 June 30, 2002..... \$100,000.00.

15 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid  
16 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund  
17 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State  
18 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his  
19 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or  
20 officers in the manner provided by law.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
22 and after July 1, 2001.
