HOUSE BILL NO. 1694

- AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 866, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1992,
- 2 AS LAST AMENDED BY CHAPTER 1034, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1999,
- 3 TO REVISE THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH COUNTY GAMING REVENUE MAY BE
- 4 EXPENDED BY TUNICA COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 866, Local and Private Laws of 1992, as
- 7 amended by Chapter 952, Local and Private Laws of 1993, as amended
- 8 by Chapter 945, Local and Private Laws of 1994, as amended by
- 9 Chapter 942, Local and Private Laws of 1995, as amended by Chapter
- 10 919, Local and Private Laws of 1997, as amended by Chapter 948,
- 11 Local and Private Laws of 1998, as amended by Chapter 1034, Laws
- 12 of 1999, is amended as follows:
- 13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Tunica County,
- 14 Mississippi, is authorized to impose a fee in an amount not to
- 15 exceed three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) of the gross gaming
- 16 revenue of a gaming vessel per calendar month, on any vessel
- 17 docked on Buck Lake, Mhoon Landing or on any other navigable
- 18 waters that have been zoned for gaming by the Tunica County Board
- 19 of Supervisors as defined in Section 27-109-1, Mississippi Code of
- 20 1972, which is located in or which is contiguous to Tunica County.
- 21 If the amount of fees required to be reported and paid
- 22 pursuant to this section is later determined to be greater or less
- 23 than the amount actually reported and paid by the vessel, the
- 24 Chairman of the State Tax Commission shall:
- 25 (a) Assess and collect the additional fees determined
- 26 to be due, with interest thereon until paid; or

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                   Advise the governing authority to refund any
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    overpayment, with interest thereon, to the vessel.
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    be computed, until paid, at the rate of one percent (1%) per month
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    from the first day of the first month following either the due
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    date of the additional fee or the date of overpayment.
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         The State Tax Commission shall calculate, collect and enforce
    the collection of the fee as provided for the calculation,
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    collection and enforcement of the license fee under Section
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    75-76-177, Mississippi Code of 1972. Not less than thirty (30)
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    days before the effective date of the fee, the board of
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    supervisors shall furnish the State Tax Commission a certified
    copy of the resolution enacting the fee and establishing the
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    effective date, which shall be the first day of any month.
    proceeds of such tax shall be paid to Tunica County on or before
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    the tenth day of the month following the month in which collected.
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    Such monies shall be deposited into the county treasury.
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    monies shall be expended by the county as follows: twelve percent
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    (12%) shall be deposited in the county general road fund and may
    be expended for any of the purposes for which monies in the
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    general road fund of the county may be expended; fourteen percent
    (14%) shall be deposited into the county general fund and may be
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    expended for any of the purposes for which monies in the general
    fund of the county may be expended; fifty percent (50%) shall be
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    deposited into a special fund in the county treasury and may be
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    expended for the construction, support, or maintenance of roads
    and bridges, public or nonprofit water and sewer systems, public
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    or nonprofit airports, public or nonprofit convention centers,
    storm water drainage and flood prevention, public recreation uses,
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    public buildings, public education facilities, medical facilities
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    and public transportation systems; provided, however, that no
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    funds shall be expended on projects related to the sale or
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    distribution of gas or electricity; twelve percent (12%) shall be
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    expended for educational purposes in Tunica County; ten percent
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(10%) shall be paid to the Town of Tunica for deposit into the 60 61 general fund of the municipality for expenditure for the purposes 62 of the support, operation or maintenance of fire protection, 63 streets, sidewalks and related structures, libraries, airports, 64 municipal water and sewer systems both within and outside the 65 corporate limits, municipal buildings, parks and recreation, the police department, supervision and finance, advertising and 66 bringing into favorable notice the opportunities, possibilities 67 and resources of the municipality, and debt service as to existing 68 outstanding debt of the municipality as of the effective date of 69 70 this act; and two percent (2%) shall be expended for educational purposes in Tunica County which shall include and be limited to 71 72 teacher's salary supplementation and teacher training. The board of supervisors may decrease the fee or increase the 73 fee up to an amount equal to, but not exceeding, three and 74 two-tenths percent (3.2%) of the gross revenue of the vessels 75 76 annually. The State Tax Commission shall be notified not less 77 than thirty (30) days before the effective date of the change. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 78

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and after its passage.

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
