## HOUSE BILL NO. 1708

1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF FRIARS POINT, MISSISSIPPI, TO OPERATE ITS NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF FRIARS POINT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section
7	21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing
8	authorities of the Town of Friars Point in Coahoma County,
9	Mississippi, in their discretion, may construct, expand, operate
10	and maintain a natural gas distribution system to provide natural
11	gas service to the following described area if that area is not
12	certified to another natural gas utility for such service, or if
13	certified, upon obtaining a release from that utility and
14	obtaining a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from
15	the Public Service Commission:
16	Beginning at a point where the East bank of the
17	Mississippi River intersects the East boundary of
18	Section 16, Township 29 North, Range 4 West in Coahoma
19	County, Mississippi; thence South approximately 1 mile
20	to the Southeast corner of said Section 16; thence East
21	approximately 7 miles to the Northeast corner of Section
22	22, Township 29 North, Range 3 West; thence South 1 1/2
23	miles to the Southeast corner of the North 1/2 of
24	Section 27; thence West 2 miles to the Southwest corner
25	of the North $1/2$ of Section 28; thence South 1 $1/2$ miles
26	to the Southeast corner of Section 32, Township 29
27	North, Range 3 West; thence West 4 miles to the

Southwest corner of Section 35, Township 29 North, Range 28 4 West; thence South 3 1/2 miles to the Northwest corner 29 of the South 1/2 Section 23, Township 28 North, Range 4 30 31 West; thence East 1 1/2 miles to the Northeast corner of 32 the Southwest 1/4 of Section 24, Township 28 North, 33 Range 4 West; thence South approximately 2 3/4 miles to the Southeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the 34 Northwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 27 North, Range 4 35 West; thence West 1 mile to the Southwest corner of the 36 Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 2, 37 38 Township 27 North, Range 4 West; thence North 1 1/4 miles to the Northwest corner of the East 1/2 of the 39 East 1/2 Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 4 West; 40 thence West 1 3/4 miles to the Southwest corner of 41 Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 4 West; thence 42 North 2 miles to the Southeast corner of Section 16, 43 Township 28 North, Range 4 West; thence West 2 1/2 miles 44 45 to the Southwest corner of the East 1/2 of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 4 West; thence North 46 47 approximately 5 1/2 miles to the East bank of the Mississippi River in Township 29 North, Range 4 West; 48 49 thence Northeasterly along the said East bank of the Mississippi River approximately 2 1/2 miles to the East 50 boundary of Section 16 and the point of beginning, all 51 52 the above being in Coahoma County, Mississippi. Whenever such service is furnished to any consumer residing 53 outside the corporate limits of the Town of Friars Point, the 54 consumer may not be charged at a rate greater than twice the rate 55 56 charged for the same service within the corporate limits of the Town of Friars Point. 57 (2) The authority conferred by this act shall not be 58

construed as an exemption from the provisions of Chapter 3, Title

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- 61 obtain from the Public Service Commission a Certificate of Public
- 62 Convenience and Necessity and approval of all rates and changes
- 63 for providing natural gas service to those areas that are more
- 64 than one (1) mile outside its corporate boundaries, and the town
- otherwise shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Public
- 66 Service Commission as authorized by applicable law.
- 67 (3) The governing authorities of the Town of Friars Point
- 68 must provide natural gas service to each consumer within the
- 69 distribution system who requests such service. For the purpose of
- 70 this subsection, the term "distribution system" means all areas
- 71 that are described in this act.
- 72 (4) The governing authorities of the Town of Friars Point
- 73 shall file annually with the State Auditor for his review a
- 74 financial report on the natural gas distribution system. The
- 75 audited financial statements shall be maintained in the office of
- 76 the system for public inspection and shall be made available to
- 77 the public during normal business hours.
- 78 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after its passage.
