HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 31

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE MISSISSIPPI SECRETARY
2 OF STATE TO STUDY FEASIBILITY OF A UNIFORM STATEWIDE ELECTORAL
3 PROCESS.

4 WHEREAS, the closeness of the 1999 Gubernatorial Election and
5 the 2000 Presidential Election reveals the importance of every
6 vote and how those votes should be counted; and

7 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi uses several different
8 types of machines to count the votes cast in any given election;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi should seek to have a
11 uniform election system that prevents fraud, eliminates voter
12 confusion and brings all 82 counties into a uniform process:

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
14 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
15 THEREIN, That we do hereby require the Mississippi Secretary of
16 State to study the feasibility of a uniform statewide electoral
17 process.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
19 furnished to the Mississippi Secretary of State and to the members
20 of the Capitol Press Corps.
