HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 63

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE SOUTHAVEN HIGH SCHOOL

18 inspired by Head Coach Valerie Cagle and Assistant Coach Ruth Anne  
19 Gammell, who have broadened the players knowledge of the game and
