HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 77

1 2 3	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE THE INCREASED COST OF GAS AND OTHER ENERGY SOURCES.
4	WHEREAS, in recent months, Mississippians have endured the
5	coldest winter the state has seen in countless years; and
6	WHEREAS, government estimates show that the residential price
7	for gas has increased forty-six percent (46%) since the same time
8	last year; and
9	WHEREAS, the average family is facing natural gas bills that
10	are sixty-two percent (62%) higher from last winter and heating
11	oil costs up thirty-eight percent (38%); and
12	WHEREAS, many Mississippians, particularly those on fixed
13	incomes, have found themselves in need of help in paying their
14	excessively high heating and utility bills during this significant
15	crisis; and
16	WHEREAS, in addition to the undue hardship being placed on
17	residential gas consumers, skyrocketing heating bills and energy
18	prices have a significant impact on the entire economy; and
19	WHEREAS, soaring energy bills are eating deeply into the
20	budgets of schools, hospitals, churches and homeless shelters
21	across the state, which entities cannot raise the prices on their
22	products or services to make up for the higher energy costs:
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
24	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
25	THEREIN, That the Legislature does hereby urge the Mississippi
26	Public Service Commission to conduct a thorough investigation into
27	the rising cost of gas and other energy sources and to identify

- 28 the basis for the significant increases faced by residential and
- 29 commercial consumers throughout the state.
