HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 108

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING WILLIAM E. LEHMAN FOR HIS  
2 MANY YEARS OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE WITH THE MISSISSIPPI AUTOMOBILE  
3 DEALERS' ASSOCIATION.

4 WHEREAS, William E. Lehman has been working for the  
5 Mississippi Automobile Dealers' Association for more than 20  
6 years; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Lehman, a native of Akron, Ohio, graduated from  
8 Kent State University and the Institute for Organization  
9 Management at Notre Dame University; and

10 WHEREAS, having faithfully served his country, Mr. Lehman was  
11 decorated in Vietnam as an Army Infantry soldier in 1968; and

12 WHEREAS, in 1979, Mr. Lehman moved to Mississippi and became  
13 the Executive Vice President of the Mississippi Automobile  
14 Dealers' Association; and

15 WHEREAS, after serving as Executive Vice President, Mr.  
16 Lehman's title was changed to President of the Mississippi  
17 Automobile Dealers' Association in 1998; and

18 WHEREAS, from February 4, 2000, to February 4, 2001, Mr.  
19 Lehman served as President of the International Automotive Trade  
20 Association Executives, which is an organization composed of over  
21 100 state and metropolitan association executives whose members  
22 are the 20,000 new car and truck dealers throughout the United  
23 States and Canada; and

24 WHEREAS, the executives representing the 50 states typically  
25 provide their members with professional development programs,  
26 legislative representation, legal services, industry relations,

27 insurance programs and a wide variety of products and services;

29 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize  
30 and commend outstanding Mississippians such as Mr. Lehman for his  
31 many years of outstanding service to Mississippi's automobile  
32 dealers:

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
34 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
35 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Mr. William E. Lehman for his  
36 many years of service with the Mississippi Automobile Dealers'  
37 Association and extend our heartiest wishes for success in all his
