HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 117

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE MOBILE MISSIONARIES
2 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING SERVICE.

3 WHEREAS, the Mobile Missionaries Assistance Program (MMA
4 are all retired interdenominational Christian couples who
5 volunteer to travel in their own self-contained accommodations,
6 furnish their own tools and work free; and

7 WHEREAS, MMA participates in various types of projects such
8 as helping at church-related campgrounds, orphanages, missions and
9 other select Christian organizations across the United States,
10 Canada and Mexico; and

11 WHEREAS, on November 19, 2000, Good Hope United Methodist
12 Church on County Road near Vaiden, Mississippi, lost its church
13 building due to a devastating fire; and

14 WHEREAS, MMA, whose project season for this region is
15 October 2000 through April 2001, has helped rebuild the small
16 rural church with the help of many volunteers; and

17 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
18 and commend outstanding service by groups such as the Mobile
19 Missionaries Assistance Program:

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
21 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
