HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 122

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MS. FAYE GILBERT UPON  
2 BEING NAMED THE 2000 ELSIE M. HOOD OUTSTANDING TEACHER OF THE YEAR  
3 AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI.

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Faye Gilbert, an associate professor of  
5 marketing, was named the 2000 Elsie M. Hood Outstanding Teacher of  
6 the Year at the University of Mississippi; and

7 WHEREAS, the Elsie M. Hood Outstanding Teacher of the Year  
8 for the University of Mississippi is selected from nominations by  
9 students, alumni and faculty; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Gilbert earned an associate's degree from City  
11 Colleges of Chicago in West Germany in 1978; a bachelor's degree  
12 from the University of Southern Mississippi in 1982; a master's  
13 degree from the University of Southern Mississippi in 1983; and a  
14 doctorate degree from the University of North Texas in 1988; and

15 WHEREAS, in 1983, Ms. Gilbert began her teaching career at  
16 the University of Southern Mississippi as an instructor in the  
17 Department of Marketing; and

18 WHEREAS, in 1984, Ms. Gilbert went to the University of North  
19 Texas, where she served as a teaching fellow and lecturer for  
20 several years; and

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Gilbert returned to Mississippi in 1988, as an  
22 assistant professor in the Department of Marketing at the  
23 University of Southern Mississippi; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Gilbert joined the faculty at the University of  
25 Mississippi in June 1989 as an assistant professor of the  
26 Department of Management and Marketing; and

27           WHEREAS, Ms. Gilbert brought to her students a teaching  
28 philosophy strong on work ethic and responsibility as well as  
29 creative approaches to challenges presented by a constantly  
30 changing world; and

31           WHEREAS, in addition to her teaching responsibilities, Ms.  
32 Gilbert is active with her students outside the classroom, having  
33 initiated an Ole Miss student chapter of the American Marketing  
34 Association, the world's largest professional society in the  
35 field; and

36           WHEREAS, with research being the foundation of good teaching,  
37 Ms. Gilbert has published more than 60 articles, text supplements  
38 and conference papers since arriving at Ole Miss; and

39           WHEREAS, Ms. Gilbert is an active member of many professional  
40 organizations including the Society for Marketing Advances  
41 Association, the Southern Marketing Association, Southwestern  
42 Marketing Association and many others; and

43           WHEREAS, Ms. Gilbert has been lovingly supported in all her  
44 endeavors by her husband, John; and

45           WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize  
46 and commend outstanding educators such as Ms. Gilbert, who has  
47 dedicated her career to teaching the young people of this state:

48           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
49 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
50 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Ms. Faye  
51 Gilbert upon being named the 2000 Elsie M. Hood Outstanding  
52 Teacher of the Year at the University of Mississippi and express  
53 our heartiest wishes for success in all her future endeavors.
