15	classroom instructor in 1964 and has served in various
16	administrative positions, including Dean of Career Education at
17	Lake City Community College in Florida; Vice President for
18	Instructional Affairs at Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College
19	in Perkinston, Mississippi; and Vice President of the Perkinston
20	Campus of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College; and
21	WHEREAS, during his tenure as President of Mississippi Delta
22	Community College, Dr. Garvin has increased enrollment from
23	approximately 1,800 students to over 2,700; and
24	WHEREAS, in addition, Dr. Garvin has overseen the expansion
25	of the campus, which includes a new science building, an addition
26	to the Allied Health complex for a dental hygiene program and
